



Many small towns, both incorporated and unincorporated, are within a few miles of the base. The surrounding counties are rich in both historic and geographic interests.

**MANCHESTER** - the county seat of Coffee County, is the closest incorporated city to the base. Manchester has a population of about 9,400 and its economy is a mixture of agricultural, business, small industry, and professional. **TULLAHOMA** - is the largest city in the immediate vicinity of the base and has a population of approximately 18,000. Tullahoma first experienced accelerated growth during WWII when two major military installations were located there - Camp Forrest and William Northern Field. Tullahoma offers many points of interest to include George Dickel Distillery, K2 Inc. sporting goods manufacturer, and ATK-GASL, an advanced weapon & space systems company. **LYNCHBURG** (Moore County) - is the home of Jack Daniel's Distillery and Motlow State Community College. Jack Daniel's Distillery is the oldest registered distillery in the country and is a National Historic Site. **SHELBYVILLE** (Bedford County) - is known for the world-famous Tennessee Walking Horse and the National Walking Horse Celebration. The first Celebration was held in 1939 and today includes a barn decorating contest, dog show, trade fair and the highlight of the evening offers great equine competition, glamour and splendor. **McMINNVILLE** (Warren County) - is a wonderland of pristine mountain tops, lush valley floors and serene lakeside retreats with sun drenched shores. **WINCHESTER** - is the Franklin County seat, has over 7,000 residents and is located in a setting of mountains, lakes, and rolling farmland. Half of Franklin County is forested with great hiking and hunting opportunities and there are two large lakes for some of the best bass fishing in the Southeast. **NASHVILLE** (Davidson County) - a major center for music, entertainment, business, health care, religious publishing, higher education, and state government. Nashville has an area population of 1.6 million and has 36 colleges/universities and 23 accredited hospitals. Some tourist attractions include the Wildhorse Saloon, a 66,000 sq ft, 3-level country music dance club and restaurant ([www.wildhorsesaloon.com](http://www.wildhorsesaloon.com)), the Grand Ole Opry, the longest running aired live radio program ([www.grandoleopry.com](http://www.grandoleopry.com)), and places like Tootsie's Orchid Lounge, Hard Rock Café, Country Music Hall of Fame and many, many more. **CHATTANOOGA** (Hamilton County) - host to arts & crafts shows, museums, the famous Chattanooga Choo Choo, riding stables and more. 

Arnold Engineering Development Center (AEDC), Arnold Air Force Base, Tennessee has long been known among the military community as “the best kept secret in the Air Force”.

Not anymore – **the secret is out!** Most people don't realize there is an Air Force Base in Tennessee much less the most advanced and largest complex of flight simulation test facilities in the world serving the Department of Defense, NASA, commercial and international customers. AEDC has contributed to the development of nearly every national aerospace program since the 1950s.

AEDC is between Nashville and Chattanooga, roughly in the center of a triangle formed by the cities of Manchester, Tullahoma and Winchester and straddles the border of Coffee and Franklin counties. The base is situated on a 40,000 acre reservation. The industrial or controlled area of the base comprises about 3,600 acres. The 4,000 acre man-made lake, Woods Reservoir, has 75 miles of shoreline and embraces many of the Services Club Arnold leisure activities.

**Youth Programs**

Youth Programs provides a safe, fun and learning environment for ages 9-18. Video games, computers, musical instruments, interactive room and other activities are available. Directed programs include summer day camp, Missoula Children's Theatre, and Easter Egg Hunt. Youth Programs runs the Family Child Care Program and is affiliated with Boys & Girls Clubs, 4-H and Youth Employment Skills.



**Golf Course**

Arnold Golf Course is near Tullahoma about 7 miles from the main base. It is a 9 hole course allowing private cart use with 2 practice greens, lighted range, pro shop, and grill. Mulligan's Grill serves breakfast and lunch 7 days a week and is a “Proud to Brew” Starbucks member.



**Arnold Lakeside Center**

Arnold Lakeside Center (ALC) is a consolidated community center and club overlooking Woods Reservoir. The center offers dining specialties from prime rib to Hap's pizza. Enjoy Hap's Pizza or Express Menu during Thursday free movie nights. Catering services are available for events such as wedding receptions, reunions, or business meetings. The ALC can orchestrate a week-long conference, full-day seminar or luncheon meeting equipped with video and audio capabilities. The main ballroom seats up to 300 and side rooms can accommodate smaller groups. The center has a bar and lounge area with darts, crud table, Wii system, Texas Hold 'Em tables, shuffleboard and sports programming. Information, Tickets and Tours has a variety of discount tickets for purchase and can assist with special orders. \*



**Outdoor Recreation**

Outdoor Recreation (ODR) is the hub for marina, FamCamp, Crockett Cove, equipment rental, auto shop, RV/boat storage, beaches/lifeguards, pavilion rental, licenses and permits. The marina offers rental of pontoons, fish/ski boats, and canoes. A boating class is required before renting. Also located on the banks of Woods Reservoir are the FamCamp and Crockett Cove. FamCamp offers tent sites and camper sites with water, 50 amp service, and laundry facilities. Boat docks, a boat ramp, beach, pavilion, playground, bathhouse and small convenience store are available. Crockett Cove offers rustic cabins with heat/air, mini fridge, microwave, porch swing, grill and picnic table. A bathhouse is on site along with beach, boat dock, pavilion and volleyball. Auto shop is a great place for do-it-yourself repairs or staff assisted tire repair. Equipment rental includes tents, canopies, tables, chairs, grills, etc.



**Fitness Center**

The Fitness Center has a basketball / volleyball court, racquetball court, state-of-the-art exercise equipment, free weights, showers and lockers. Team sports include softball, basketball, volleyball, golf, football, bowling, and tennis. Group classes consist of cycling, Zumba, piloga, yoga, Pilates, and karate. A 1.8 mile wooded trail is adjacent to the center. Some areas are for eligible users only.



**Gossick Leadership Ctr**

The Gossick Leadership Center (GLC) is a premiere meeting facility located on the shores of Woods Reservoir. The GLC is available for official or unofficial functions. Unofficial functions will be charged a fee based affiliation. Event catering is available from Arnold Lakeside Center. \*
